Bia Bluestem Andropogon gerardii Warm season grass that grows in upright clumps. Height: 2-6.5' Blooms: Jun-Sept Light: Full to part sun Soil: Dry-Moist-Wet

Value: S, C, NS



Black (Smooth) Alder Alnus serrulata High wildlife value. Forms thickets, tolerates flooding. Height: 12-20' Blooms: Mar-Apr Light: Sun Soil: Moist-Wet Value: S, C, F, CP, NS



Northern Bayberry Morella pensylvanica Waxy berries provide winter bird food. Need male and female. Height: 5-10' Blooms: Mar-Apr Light: Sun-Part Sun Soil: Drv-Moist-Wet Value: C, F, CP, NS



Purple Joe-pye Weed Eutrochium purpureum Large domed flowerheads very attractive to many pollinators. Height: 2-6.5' Blooms: Jul-Oct Light: Sun-part sun



New Jersey Tea Ceanothus americanus Hardy, compact shrub. Tolerates dryness. White masses of tiny flowers. Height: 3' Blooms: May-Sept Light: Sun-Part Sun Soil: Drv Value: Ś, C, F, CP



White Pine Pinus strobus Fast growing evergreen canopy tree. Height: 75-100' Spread: 50-75' Blooms: May-Jul Light: Sun Soil: Dry-Moist Value: S, C, CP, NS



Bergamot Monarda fistulosa Showy flowers attract hummingbirds, bees and butterflies. Height: 1.5-5' Blooms: Jun-Sept Light: Sun-Part sun Soil: Dry-Moist Value: CP, N



Fragrant Sumac Rhus aromatica Fast growing, hardy, forms thickets. Fuzzy berry clusters provide winter food. Height: 6' Blooms: Mar-May Light: Sun-Part Sun Soil: Drv Value: C, F, CP



Black Cherry Prunus serotina Fruit eaten by 33 species of birds. Fast growing, showy. Height: 40-75' Spread: 20-35' Bloom: Mav-Jun Liaht: Sun Soil: Dry-Moist Value: C, F, CP, NS



Cardinal Flower Lobelia cardinalis Showy red spikes attract hummingbirds. Re-seeds. Good in rain gardens. Height: 2-4' Blooms: Jul-Oct Light: Sun-Part Sun Soil: Moist-Wet Value: CP, N



Highbush Blueberry Vaccinium corymbosum Multi-stemmed adaptable shrub. Songbirds relish the edible berries. Height: 6-12' Blooms: Apr-Jun Light: Sun-Part Sun-Shade Soil: Drv-Moist-Wet Value: C, F, CP



Sugar Maple Acer saccharum Large tree with round, dense crown. High wildlife value. Height: 60-100' Spread: 50-75' Bloom: Apr-May Light: Sun-Part Sun-Shade Soil: Dry-Moist

Value to birds: Seeds (S), Cover (C), Fruit (F), Caterpillars (CP), Nectar (N), Nest Sites (NS)
